In less than three years you will be milking half blood dairy heifers, in less than five years you will have three-quarter bloods, then seven-eighths, and soon the herd will be practically pure bred and money makers. He should be from a cow that is a really first class dairy animal, and both of his grandams and still farther back should be high class producers.
