Two Road Meetings.

E. L. Root, supervisor of Road District No. 10, went to The Dalles Tuesday to post in the court house a notice of a public meeting of the taxpayers in his district, to be held December 29, to vote a special tax levy for road purposes in District No. 10.

It is a privilege, freely exercised by many otherwise good American citizens, to "roar" whenever a "special tax levy" is mentioned, no matter for what purpose it is to be used.
