OUR PORTLAND LETTER

Portland, Ore. Dec. 13, (Special) - Oregon's recent apple show was not only a great fruit exposition but it marked the beginning of a movement to organize the fruit growers of the whole Pacific Northwest on a practical basis for more profitable handling of their product.

Prominent apple growers, representing the various districts, will participate in the formation of the company, which will be along the lines of the raisin growers of the Sacramento Valley, the orange growers of Riverside, Cal., and the pear growers of the Rogue River Valley.

The biggest wheat cargo ever sent away from the Columbia River was that taken the past week by the Norwegian tramp steamship, the Bjornstjerne Bjornsen, which sailed with 305,866 bushels for Europe.

Oregon has a population of 672,765, according to the figures of the thirteenth census, an increase of 62.7 per cent over ten years ago, when the state had 413,536.

James J. Hill, who has been playing Santa Claus to Oregon for the past few years and presenting the state with new railroads, will visit the state before Christmas, according to present plans, and will be given a warm reception at Portland.

Medford has a chance to crow over the showing made by the late census as disclosed in the reports recently issued. With one exception, says the census bureau, Medford shows the greatest percentage of growth of any city in the United States during the last ten year period.

The protected cruiser Boston has been ordered turned over to the Oregon Naval Reserve for use in maneuvers and in perfecting the training of the volunteer sailors who make up the organization.

New Real Estate Dealer L. A. Mathews has entered the real estate field and made his first deal this week when he negotiated the sale of E. E. Fraedrick's property on Mosier creek, consisting of about 10 acres, to Mrs. R. S. Greenleaf, of Portland.

Oregon Activities

Oregon City has a paper mill that is the third largest in the world. Four hundred boxes of Comice pears, grown near Medford, sold in the London market this season for \$10 a box.

Siberia is buying Oregon apples. One hundred boxes of choice Hood River fruit was recently shipped there for sale. Oregon's financial condition, as shown by the State Treasurer's report, is in excellent condition.

A large acreage around Hermiston is being seeded to alfalfa. This is not only a profitable crop for hay but there is money in raising seed, which brings 23 cents per pound. Rogue River orchardists will plant 1,500,000 pear and apple trees this season.

The annual report of the Portland Union Stockyards Company shows Portland is becoming a great packing center. The value of livestock shipped the first year of the concern was in operation amounted to \$8,325,000.

Oregon raises the best apples. This is no idle boast for not only has this state won the sweepstakes prize at the Spokane National Apple Show two successive years but also captured the first prize of \$1,000 at the Chicago show this year.

Estacada, an Oregon town seven years of age, has become one of the most prosperous communities of its size and is attracting much attention as a fruit section. It ranks high in apple and walnut production.

State banks have been prosperous the past year, as shown by the annual report of State Bank Examiner Wright, who found individual deposits in Oregon banks on November 10 totaled \$104,270,300, a net gain since November 16, 1909, of \$14,221,550.
