LUNCH FOR EVENING GUESTS

Simple Refreshments Easily Prepared Without Spending Much Money or Effort.

When girl friends drop in unexpectedly for the evening dainty refreshments add much to the pleasure of the guests without causing any great expenditure of either money or effort. Hot chocolate is a favorite beverage of all womankind and the truly hospitable woman is always an adept at making it.

To make hot chocolate allow one ounce of chocolate to each pint of liquid. To make one quart put two ounces of chocolate in a double boiler with one pint of hot water. Stir until the chocolate is melted, then add one pint of rich milk. Beat and stir rapidly until it boils again. Add three tablespoons of sugar, take from the fire and beat quickly. Have the chocolate pot hot when the chocolate is turned in and served with whipped cream. If slightly thickened chocolate is desired make a thin paste of two teaspoonsful of cornstarch moistened with milk and stir slowly into the mixture just before it is taken from the stove.

Dainty sandwiches to serve with the chocolate are made by cutting white bread into thin slices and spreading them with a paste made of finely chopped pecan nut meats and mayonnaise. Lettuce sandwiches have a leaf of crisp lettuce spread with the mayonnaise as filling. Butter the bread before using the filling. Some hostesses keep a jar of chopped nuts or peanut butter on hand all the time and so are never at a loss when the unexpected guest drops in. Peanut sandwiches are made by spreading one slice of the bread thinly with butter and the other with the peanut butter. Put together with a lettuce leaf.

FOREIGN TRADE UP IN BILLIONS

Fiscal Year Just Completed Breaks All Records.

Balance in Favor of Home Products \$520,000,000—Half of Imports Enter Free of Duty.

Washington, July 17.—All foreign business records of the United States were broken during the fiscal year ended June 30. Figures of the bureau of statistics issued today show that the volume of foreign business amounted to the enormous sum of more than \$3,500,000,000, which exceeded the record year of 1907 by more than \$263,000,000.

The country's exports for the first time exceeded the \$2,000,000,000 mark, while the imports were second only to last year's. The year closed with a balance of trade of more than \$520,000,000 in favor of American business.

This is \$332,000,000 more than last year's balance, but was exceeded by the record years of 1908 and 1901 and 1900 and 1899.

Fifty per cent of the imports entered the country free of duty, being greater than at any time in the history of the trade, except in 1892-93-94, when sugar was being imported free under the McKinley tariff law.

The total value of merchandise entering free, however, was larger than in any year heretofore.

NORTHWEST HAS HOTTEST DAY IN PAST FOUR YEARS

Portland, July 17.—Portland was not the hottest place in the Pacific Northwest yesterday, though for two hours in the afternoon, while perspiring folk stamped about in shades and coats, the thermometer stood at 97 degrees, and Brother Beals, the genial weather man, registered the hottest consecutive 120 minutes since 1907. But that 97 degrees was as the gentle warmth of a day in spring, compared to the heat in other towns in Oregon, Washington and Idaho.

In 11 cities that had been heard from last night, the thermometer stood above 100 degrees. Eltopia, a little water tank station in Central Washington, near Pasco, was perhaps the hottest place in the United States, the mercury climbing to 110 degrees.

Following were the maximum temperatures Sunday in Pacific Northwest cities: Portland 97; Albany 102; Salee 102; Roseburg 105; The Dalles 104; Bend 98; Seattle 92; Vancouver 99; Walla Walla 108; Ashland 104; Baker 96; Boise 98; Marshfield 70; North Yakima 106; Tacoma 88; Goldendale 106; Pullman 100; Lewiston 106; Eltopia 110; Spokane 99.

Squab Grows Fast.

A squab grows enormously the first 12 hours, and still more rapidly after the third day. Squabs are at first sparsely covered with long filaments of down, the root of each filament indicating the point from which each feather is to start. The down for a while still hangs on the tips of some of the feathers, during their growth, and is thought by some to be finally absorbed into the shaft of the growing feather.

Bread Griddle Cakes.

One and one-half cups flour, one cup stale bread crumbs, three teaspoons baking powder, one teaspoon salt, two tablespoons sugar, one-half cup boiling water, three-quarters cup milk, one egg, well beaten, two tablespoons melted butter. Add boiling water to the bread crumbs and let stand five minutes. Add the milk, sift together thoroughly the flour, salt, sugar, and baking powder, and add to the bread mixture; then add the egg and butter. Fry as griddle cakes.
