REGISTER!

ONLY SIX DAYS MORE, SO GET BUSY

There are only six days more in which to register. So far the registration has been very light, whether from indifference or a habit of "putting off things" it is hard to say. If the voter would stop to consider the inconvenience to the election board and the time and trouble it takes to be "sworn in" on election day, he would exert himself to register before the books close.

The registration for East Mosier precinct is as follows:
Republicans..... 54
Democrats..... 28
Prohibitionists..... 24
Independents..... 2
Socialists..... 2

Total..... 110

Of this number 31 are women.

Registration for West Mosier:
Republicans..... 35
Democrats..... 8
Prohibitionists..... 3
Independent..... 1
Socialist..... 2
Ind. Socialist..... 1

Total..... 50

Of this number 15 are women.

From these figures it will be seen that 35 of the total registration so far cannot vote at the primary election next month. Of this number there are no doubt many who would like to see candidates on both the republican and democrat tickets nominated, as they have no ticket of their own to support. Had they desired to vote at the primary they should have registered as republicans or democrats, thus helping to nominate their choice of candidates, as there are many on both the dominant tickets for state and county offices who are good and competent men; men for whom these 35 would vote if they were on their ticket. But having registered as other than republicans or democrats they cannot vote at all, thus losing the right to express their preference at the primary.

It is not only a privilege but a

duty to vote at every election. Deprive the voter of the franchise and what a roar goes up. Let him deprive himself and it's nobody's business. It is no disloyalty to the prohibition party, if it has no ticket in the field, to register as a member of another party in order to get good men in office.

The registration books will be closed before we go to press again and we urge every one not registered, who wishes to vote, to come in and register on or before next Tuesday evening, at 6 o'clock. This is the last call.

LOCAL BANK WILL BUILD

ONE STORY BRICK BUILDING, 25X50 FEET, TO RISE SOON

Mosier's first brick building will soon be in course of construction, according to the decision of the directors of the Mosier Valley Bank, at a recent meeting.

The building will be a one-story brick, 25x50 feet in size, and will occupy the lot at the corner of Main Street and Third Avenue, the present site of the library building.

Plans and specifications for the building are being prepared by Manager Harms, of the Tum-A-Lum Lumber Co., and when completed they will be submitted to various contractors for bids on the construction of the edifice.

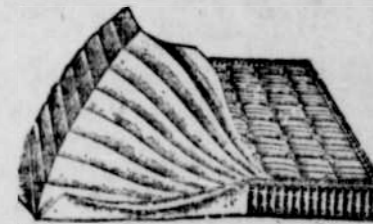
