PRUNE PACKING IN FULL SWING

The warerooms of the Mosier Fruit Growers Association present a busy scene these days, as the prune packing season is in full swing. About fifty women and girls are required to do the packing and they work at high tension from morning till night.

Each year new faces are seen at the packing tables, as it is impossible to keep all of the old packers, and the number required to do the work must be recruited from the outside. This year there are a number who came from Hood River, Portland and other places, tho the majority of the workers are local people.

The prune packing will probably last another week.

A. J. DERBY WILL FRAME MOSIER'S CHARTER

A. J. Derby, the well known Hood River attorney, who has been retained by the common council to look after the interests of the City of Mosier, was in town Wednesday night and attended a meeting of the council. The city fathers have been investigating the charters of various Oregon municipalities, and have decided that a charter based on the kind under which Hood River is working would do for Mosier, and as Judge Derby revised that charter, the city fathers wisely concluded to secure Mr. Derby's services in framing a suitable charter for Mosier.

It is probable that the charter will be ready to submit to the citizens of Mosier for acceptance by the middle of September.

MOSIER MAN HONORED

An honor unsought is always more an honor than when it is striven for. Such an honor has come to Dr. C. A. Macrum, which was entirely unsolicited, who has been appointed a member of the state horticultural board, succeeding R. H. Weber of The Dalles, who held the position for some years.

Dr. Macrum is a thorough student of horticulture and has evolved some practical ideas in the treatment of orchards. He thinks that, owing to the unusually long dry season, it would be advisable to do extra cultivating, thus conserving the moisture. He is also making private experiments in the matter of spraying and other orchard work and feels confident that his ideas will work out successfully.

MUST PUBLISH ELECTION CALL

Attention is called to the fact that Attorney General Crawford has rendered an opinion that where a school district holds an election without publishing the call, the election is invalid. The opinion was rendered at the request of State Superintendent of Public Instruction Churchill. The mere posting of notices of a call does not make the election valid.

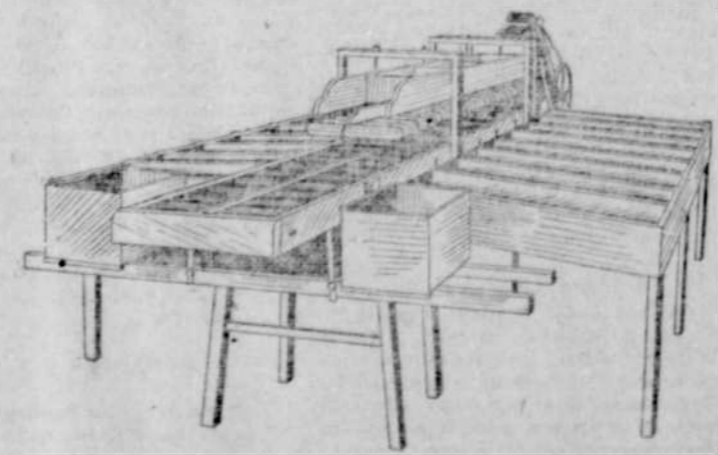
