Notice of Proposed Amendment to the Charter of the City of Mosier, Oregon

Notice is hereby given that the following amendment to Section 2 of the Charter of the City of Mosier, Oregon, has been filed with me by the Common Council of the City of Mosier for submission to the people of said City at a special election to be held and held therein on the 3rd day of March, 1917:

"A Measure submitted to the people of the City of Mosier, by the Common Council thereof, for their adoption or rejection.

Referred to the People of the City of Mosier, Oregon, for their adoption or rejection by the Common Council of said City.

Shall Section 2 of an Act or Ordinance entitled: "An Ordinance to provide a Charter for the City of Mosier, and define its powers," adopted by the people of the City of Mosier, at a special election held therein on the 26th day of September, 1914, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 2. The geographical limits and boundaries of said City as heretofore provided by law, shall be as follows:

"Beginning at the S. E. Cor. of the J. B. Mosier Donation Land Claim being situated in Secs. 1 and 2, Tp. 2 N. R. 11 E. W. M., which said cor. is a gal. iron pipe 26 in. long and 1 1/2 in. in diameter set 20 in. in the ground; thence S. 14 degrees, 14 minutes W. for 427.5 feet to 1 1/2 in. x 26 in. iron pipe, duly witnessed; S. 16 degrees, 14 minutes E. for 334.6 feet to 1 1/2 in. x 26 in. iron pipe duly witnessed; S. 15 degrees, 33 minutes W. for 112.4 feet to 1 1/2 in. x 26 in. iron pipe and marked rock; N. 88 degrees, 32 min. W. for 569.2 feet along South boundary to cor. between Secs. 1 and 2, Tp. 2 N. R. 11 E. W. M., which is an iron pipe 26 in. long and 1 1/2 in. in dia.; thence N. 88 deg. 41 min. W. 265.0 feet to the corner of Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12; North 97.3 feet between Section 1 and 2, to the South boundary of the Mosier D. L. C.; N. 84 deg. 54 min. W. 259.9 feet to the Southwest corner of the Mosier D. L. C. which is a stone 26 in. x 10 in. marked -I-S-W-M-D-L-C-S-89 deg. 48 min. W. 1473.1 feet to a point in the left bank of Rock Creek; which is a stone 24 in. x 18 in. x 12 in. marked -I-S-W-M-D-L-C-S-7 deg. 26 min. E. 132.2 feet to the center of Rock Creek; N. 44 deg. 11 min. E. 107.7 feet down center of main channel of Rock Creek; N. 22 deg. 22 min. E. 100 feet down center of main channel; N. 3 deg. 56 min. Recovering From Operation

Hans Kollanderud has returned after an extended absence. On December 16 Mr. Kollanderud left Mosier for Spokane to undergo another operation on his left leg which was broken last summer. It was necessary to cut out a portion of the leg above the break and graft it in the place where the fracture occurred. Mr. Kollanderud remained in St. Luke's hospital in Spokane for a month and since that time has been visiting in Marshfield and in the Willamette valley, stopping over in Hood River to consult with his physician Dr. J. M. Waugh, before returning to Mosier. After a short stay here, Mr. Kollanderud is planning a trip to Seattle and points on the Puget Sound and may also visit with relatives and friends in the mid-west, returning to Mosier about cherry time.

While the physicians attending Mr. Kollanderud maintain that in time he will have the free use of this leg, yet they believe, according to an X-ray picture taken recently disclosing that the wound which showed the fracture to be healing nicely, that it will be three or four months before he will be able to abandon his crutches and bear his weight on both limbs.

McDONALD SELLS 15 BEAN SPRAYERS

From the Hood River Glacier

D. McDonald, local distributor of the Bean Spray Pump Co. implements, announces the sale of 15 power spray machines. During the past few weeks, with A. F. Sanderson, a special representative of the San Jose, Cal., concern, here with Mr. McDonald, growers have evidenced an acute interest in spraying implements, and it is likely that sales of power sprayers will reach as great a number as on last season.

The total investment in these implements purchased from Mr. McDonald will reach approximately \$6,000.

The Dufur Orchard Co., according to Mr. McDonald, has purchased five of the Bean power sprayers. This concern has also purchased one of the Bean tractors.

The Bean tractor is expected by Mr. McDonald to arrive in Hood River about March 10. For three years the Bean people have been experimenting with tractors. A new machine has been originated each year, but never before has the company offered one of its tractors for sale.

"The company," says Mr. McDonald, "wants to make sure of a machine that would give satisfaction and on which they could make a guarantee. They believe they have such an implement now, and it is likely that the Bean tractor will prove quite a sensation in Hood River."

One of the features of spraying the coming year will come from the construction of towers on newly purchased implements. Mr. McDonald says he finds many orchardists, whose trees are of any size, getting designs for towers, the use of which means clean fruit in the tops of larger trees.

Stone Fears Lost Lake Bill

At the instigation of D. I. Stone, who owns a ranch on the headwaters of the West Fork of Hood River, Secretary Scott has written Representative Sinnott, asking him to watch for the introduction of a bill by Senator Harry Lane, which will provide for the addition of a large slice of the Lost Lake country to the Bull Run reserve. Mr. Stone states that he has been told that Senator Lane, in behalf of an element of Portland citizens, has been contemplating such a bill.

Hood River people maintain that Lost Lake is one of their most valuable scenic assets, and any attempt on the part of Portland to invade the Hood River water shed meets with a strong local disapproval. Secretary Scott, however, thinks it very improbable that Senator Lane will introduce such a bill as is specified in the information received by Mr. Stone.
