POOR CATTLE ARE OFFERED

Demand Heavier Than Supply—High Supply is Very Liberal.

(Special Correspondence)
PORTLAND, Nov. 22.—Cattle receipts at the Portland Union Stock Yards for the past week have not been up to the requirements of the trade, neither in point of numbers or quality, 2977 head being received. The demand has been strong and active and prices have shown a higher tendency.

The hog supply has been proportionately liberal but buyers have taken the offerings promptly at good prices, 3746 head were received and several loads brought the top of the market \$8.10, but the bulk of the sales have run from \$7.90 to \$8.05.

The receipts of sheep have in no way approximated the demand and sheep buyers have not been able to fill their orders, 1942 head were all that came in during the week. The market has been firm and higher and the demand is strong for good quality mutton and lambs.

There were 2811 cattle, 150 calves and 55 horses shipped in during the week.

Following are representative of average sales of the past week: 24 cows, average 1045, \$3.75; 27 cows, average 994, \$3.40; 25 steers, average 1225, \$4.45; 17 steers, average 1048, \$4.00; 171 weathers, average 100, \$1.00; 78 hogs, average 249, \$8.10; 52 hogs, average 241, \$8.10; 35 hogs, average 224, \$8.00; 85 hogs, average 236, \$7.90; 11 lambs, average 67, \$5.00.
