ARE TO DEVELOP LIVESTOCK MARKET

Uniform Livestock Rates Are to Be Put Into Effect—Dairy-men to Meet.

(Mail Tribune Special Service.) PORTLAND, Or., Dec. 1.—Concerted efforts to develop the Portland livestock market on a big scale have been begun during the week by livestock men of the northwest in connection with the railroads in the matter of more favorable rates. A conference was held between a number of representative stockmen. The management of the local stockyards and the centering manager of the railroads is the matter of uniform livestock rates that will be of great benefit to this market, as well as to the stockraisers throughout the territory are expected.

Oregon dairymen are showing great interest in the annual convention of the state association, to be held in Portland, December 9 and 10, and the attendance will be large. Many prizes have been offered for the best showing of dairy products made at the convention, and the exhibits will undoubtedly be the best made in recent years. The creamery companies of the state are offering prizes and the Portland flouring mills offers a purse of \$100 to go for the two best exhibits. The Portland Commercial club will give a reception Thursday evening, December 9, to the dairymen and members of the State Horticultural society.

According to W. R. Parker of Baker City, who has been in the city during the past week, Oregon has the only herd of Ilex known to exist on the continent. He discovered the rare animals in the vicinity of Mount Eagle in the Cornucopia range, and urges that a game preserve be created there for their preservation. Unless this is done, Mr. Parker fears the Ilex will be exterminated by hunters.

The Portland Fair & Livestock association has elected officers as follows for the coming year: President, E. L. Thompson; vice-president, C. C. Colt; treasurer, Julius Meier. G. A. Westgate was chosen temporary secretary. Plans are under way already for next year's fair and the management is determined to make the affair the most successful in the history of the association. Promotion of the livestock interests of the northwest is the aim of the organization.
