

STIGMA LEAVES NAME "AMERICA"

Investigator Finds That Americus Vespucci Was Not Pickle Dealer as Often Alleged.

SACRAMENTO, Cal., Dec. 15.—The stigma once on the name "America," the blot on the 'scutcheon, is no longer. Like a beauty doctor Heinrich Charles of New York, has removed the blemish from the fair land that gave us birth.

Instead of "proud America being the name of a thief and a pickle-dealer of Seville," as Emerson so scathingly said about Amerigo Vespucci, from whose cognomen "Americus Vespucci," from whose cognomen "America" was reduced, the discoverer is now found after much labor and exhaustive research to have been a perfect gentleman and a discoverer by occupation.

The labor and research fell upon Heinrich Charles a year or two ago when he set about to disprove what Emerson had said and also Benjamin H. Harrison and James G. Blaine who felt so badly about it that they advocated changing the name to something else. Now he has written an account of what he discovered about the discoverer and the whole of it is in the form of a brochure called "The American Day," a copy of which is in the hands of State Superintendent of Public Instruction Hyatt and in an inside letter that author says:

"My researches resulted in clearing up the mystery and obscurity surrounding the name and discovering the true story. There is no disgrace or stigma attached to it. On the contrary, it is the most glorious of all continental names."

The brochure carries the endorsement of some eminent historians and archaeologists.
