PROCLAMATION.

Whereas, there was submitted to the voters of the City of Medford, Oregon, at a special election held for that purpose on December 14th, 1909, a proposed amendment to the charter of the City of Medford, hereinafter set forth, and

Whereas, on the 15th day of December, 1909, the city recorder, in my presence did canvass the vote given for and against said amendment, and

Whereas, it was ascertained and determined upon said canvass that there were 395 votes cast for and 77 votes cast against said amendment, the total number of votes cast at said election being 472, and that said amendment received an affirmative majority of all the votes cast at said election.

Now therefore, I, W. H. Canon, as mayor of the City of Medford, Oregon, in obedience to and by virtue of the authority and power vested in me as such mayor, do hereby make and issue this proclamation to the people of the City of Medford, aforesaid, and do announce and declare that the whole number of votes cast at said election, and the total number of votes cast for and against said charter amendment was as hereinbefore stated, and that the said amendment received affirmative majority of the total number of votes cast at said election and that the said amendment shall be and is in full force and effect from the date of the publication of this proclamation, and that the following is the full text of the said charter amendment:

A charter amendment to the charter of the City of Medford, Oregon, amending sub-section 42 of section 25 and section 100 of said charter, fixing the time for which contracts may be entered into and franchises be granted by said city.

The people of the City of Medford do ordain as follows: Section 1. That sub-section 42 of section 25 of the charter of Medford be amended so as to read as follows: 42. No franchise or contract shall be granted by the City or City Council for a longer period than ten years, except street railway franchises, which may be granted for such period as the city council or legal voters of said city may see fit.

Section 2. That section 100 of the charter of said City of Medford be amended so as to read as follows: Section 100. No contract shall be entered into by the city or any franchise granted by it for a longer period than ten years, except franchises for street railways, which may be granted for such periods as the city council or voters of said city may see fit.

ORDINANCE NO. 273.

An ordinance declaring the assessment on the property benefitted for the cost of laying a four-inch water main on Newtown street, south, from West Eleventh to Twelfth street and directing the recorder to enter a statement thereof in the water main lien docket.

The city of Medford doth ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whereas, the city council did heretofore by resolution declare its intention to lay a four-inch water main on Newtown street, south, from West Eleventh to Twelfth street and to assess the cost thereof on the property fronting on said portion of said street in proportion to the frontage of said property, and did fix a time and place for hearing protests against the laying of said water main on said portion of said street and the assessment of the cost thereof as aforesaid.

And whereas, said resolution was duly published and posted as required by section 116 of the charter of said city.

And whereas, a meeting of the council was held at the time and place fixed in said resolution for the purpose of considering any such protests, but no such protests were at said time or at any other time made to or received by the council to the laying of said water main or the assessment of the cost thereof as aforesaid, and said council having considered the matter and deeming that said water main was and is of material benefit to said city and that all property to be assessed therefore would be benefitted thereby to the extent of the probable amount of the respective assessments to be levied against said property, did order said water main laid.

And whereas, the cost of said water main has been and hereby is determined to be the sum of \$456.72. Now therefore, it is hereby further determined that the proportionate share of the cost of laying said water main of each parcel of the property fronting on said portion of said street is the amount set opposite the description of each parcel or piece of land below and that each piece or parcel of land benefitted by the laying of said water main to the full extent of the amount set opposite the description of each parcel or piece and that the respective amounts rep-

resent the proportional benefit of said water main to said respective parcels of land and also the proportional frontage thereof on said portion of said street, and the council does hereby declare each of the parcels of property described below to be assessed and each of the same hereby is assessed the amount set opposite each description of the cost of laying said water main.

ASSESSMENT FOR A FOUR-INCH WATER MAIN ON NEWTOWN STREET, SOUTH, FROM WEST ELEVENTH STREET TO TWELFTH STREET.
