

RICH STRIKE IN OLD PLACER MINE

New Owners of the Pearce Mine on Pooram's Creek Strike a Rich Channel of Placer Gold in the Claim.

The new owners of the Pearce mine on Pooram's creek are reported to have struck a rich bed of auriferous gravel, probably the "old channel," which corresponds in the language of the placer miner to the "mother lode" in the nomenclature of quartz.

Mr. Ramsay and his associates opened up a new piece of ground away from the old workings and were not long in finding that the gravel was extremely rich in those big chunks of gold for which the mine is noted. Just what is the extent of the ground is unknown, but it is thought to cover a good sized portion of the claim.
