MONEY AMPLY SAFEGUARDED.

As there seems to be some misunderstanding regarding the disposal of the subscriptions made for the Crater Lake highway, the Commercial club committee in charge of the movement make the following statement:

No member of the commission draws any salary. The engineer for the work will be furuished gratis by

the government. No money is to be paid out except upon estimates by the engineer in charge and after being audited and approved by the committee, which consists of leading bankers

and business men of Medford. No money is to be paid for rights of way. The route to be followed will be that selected by the government engineer as the most feasible and economical. The money is to be deposited equally in the four banks of Medford, whose presidents comprise the advisory board

of the commission. The subscriptions call for half payment June 1, 1910, the remaining half in June, 1911.
