CAR PERFORMS MARVELOUS FEAT

Buick "White Streak" Makes a Record Never Before Approached by Any Car--Runs 10 Days Without Stopping, Covering 3500 Miles.

One of the most sensational endurance runs that has ever been made by an automobile west of the recent ten days' non-stop trip made by a little Buick "White Streak" in the state of Utah.

The car was to start and in ten days complete the distance of 3500 miles without the engine being stopped once. Each day of the ten in which the car was being operated was over probably the worst of roads known to the state, and each day as regularly as the clock told the hours the little white car made her run of 350 miles and at the completion of the event closed up the run with a perfectly running motor and the distance of 3500 miles to her credit.

So that there might be a perfect record and watch kept over the performance of the car and that there might be an absolute check kept over it, and no changes or stopping of the motor might occur, the driver of the machine was accompanied by a newspaper representative of one of the local newspapers of Salt Lake City during the entire run, and when the score had been completed the car was taken into the city of Salt Lake, run about the streets carrying 12 persons, and excited the utmost attention from the crowded streets. When the street demonstration had been made, and the ovation to the car closed, she was taken to the Salt Lake City auto show, where thousands viewed it with the greatest of interest.
