## TO REDUCE VETO POWER OF LORDS

Premier Asquith Prepares Resolutions Which Will Either Aid or Block Legislation—Supporters Say They Will Expedite Matters.

LONDON, March 22.—Supporters of Premier Asquith are commenting favorably today on his presentation of the resolution aiming to reduce the veto power of the house of lords. The premier gave notice last night of the resolutions.

A few of the government supporters still express disapproval that the resolutions provide that two years must elapse between the introduction of a bill and its becoming a law. They believe that these provisions would result in a general delay of legislation.

The lords probably will reject the resolutions indignantly, but it is believed that Redmond and his followers will support Asquith's suggestions. The possibility that another general election will result is being discussed.

The first resolution declares it is expedient that the house of lords be disabled by law from rejecting or amending a money bill, but any such limitation shall not be taken to diminish or qualify the existing rights of the house of commons.

The second resolution declares it is expedient that the powers of the house of lords over bills other than money bills be restricted by law so any such bill that has passed the house of commons in three successive sessions and has been rejected by the house of lords in each of these sessions shall become a law without the consent of the lords, or royal assent being declared, provided at least two years have elapsed between the date of the first introduction of the bill in the commons and the date it passes the commons for the third time.

The third resolution proposes to limit the duration of each parliament to five years.

## DEFENDS, "MY LADY NICOTINE"

French Army Doctor Says Smoking Is Excellent Medicine for Those Threatened With Brain and Spinal Attacks.

PARIS, March 22.—"My Lady Nicotine" secured a champion today in the form of Dr. D. E. Kermabon of the French army, who declared that tobacco is excellent medicine and those threatened with brain and spinal attacks ought to take the nicotine cure.

The doctor seeks to prove his assertions by statistics gathered while watching the ravages of the cerebrospinal meningitis which has been epidemic among the French troops for three months.

Dr. De Kermabon stated today that he has carefully compiled statistics in which it is shown that 20 non-tobacco users were attacked by the disease to one who was prone to the use of cigarettes and other forms of tobacco.

Dr. De Kermabon also asserted that the young should be encouraged to smoke and especially if they are liable to spinal trouble.

He declared that the festive coffin nail is a cure for "brainstorms."
