

VAUDEVILLE ON THURSDAY



Pantages' vaudeville will hold the boards at the Medford theater Thursday and Friday, May 5 and 6. The success of the last venture in this line has induced Manager Hazelrigg to take another flyer at it, especially as this show has been giving excellent satisfaction at Portland this week.

Have you heard the Marimbo band? A few years ago an aged Guatemalan and his four sons invented the marimbo in the wilds of South America. When a wandering

paleface ran across the brothers four they were 'way up in the mountains performing on the marimbo before crowds of attentive natives.

The marimbo? It is the only musical instrument of its kind in the world. It is at the Pantages theater this week and it is one of the most meritorious hits in many a moon. The secret of the marimbo's construction is jealously withheld from the prying ones and it is securely locked in a strong box after every performance.

The brothers who perform upon this

wonderful instrument are musicians to the tips of their fingers. That these four boys were discovered in the wilds of South America with one of the most unique musical instruments on the vaudeville stage today is a story in itself.

It is impossible adequately to describe the haunting, fascinating melodies of the marimbo. There is a suggestion of the xylophone about it, but only in the manner in which the four brothers play upon it. If you listen closely you can hear the sobbing of the violin, the soft tones of the flute, the twang of the banjo and the quiver of the mandolin, until all blend into one sweet melody. If you listen still more closely you can hear the pulsing chimes of silver bells sinking and fading into the deep dissonance of the organ. And the flawless artistry of the four brothers is a rare treat. These mountaineers of South America give you the soothing "Jasmines," the sprightly "Firtation Waltz," the soul-stirring "Semiramide" and a beautiful rendition of "Cavalleria Rusticana." From the classics the four brothers demonstrate their versatility by playing ragtime as it was never played before on a similar instrument. The Marimbo band is one of those rare treats which comes along once in a long time.

The trio of Baker, De Voe and Adolph will offer a comedy military act called "That's How They Saved Their Lives." It is a burlesque eccentric act introducing music, comedy, dancing and acrobatic falls.

Brooks and Carlisle are one of the smartest combinations in vaudeville. He is a typical Englishman of the Haw-Haw type and Miss Carlisle represents a fine American girl. They have been making a tremendous hit on the Pantages circuit and their smart sayings and quick repartee are said to be very funny. A fine little dialogue results, the party of the second part being the personified up-to-date American girl, always springing a new one. The last part of this act is the best, at that. It comes as a song dialogue, based on the things a man sees after dinner, when his cigar is lighted, he gazes up "in the smoke, smoke, smoke."

The Millards present "The Clod-hopper and the Girl," in which "Simple Willie from Squeekum's Corners" is perfectly portrayed. He is a "rube" who knows how to "fiddle" and she is a girl just off the "road" with a keen knowledge of various instruments. There is a good sprinkling of comedy in the act.

Riley and Ahern are the Dixie Dandies. They do singing and dancing and are the real thing in their line.
