

CITY NOTICES.

ORDINANCE NO. 3260. An ordinance declaring the assessment of the property benefited for the cost of laying a six-inch water main on Central Avenue North and directing the recorder to enter a statement thereon in the Water Main Lien Book.

Section 1. Whereas, the city council did heretofore, by resolution declare its intention to lay a six-inch water main on Central Avenue North and to assess the cost thereof on the property fronting on said portion of said street in proportion to the frontage of said property, and fix a time and place for hearing protests against the laying of said water main on said part of said street and the assessments of the cost thereof as aforesaid.
