### JAPANESE COUNT WARNS CHINESE OF TREACHERY

TOKYO, June 11.—Count Okuma, discussing the recent Russo-Japanese treaty negotiations, today sounded a warning to China to avoid being misled by representations of foreign powers jealous of the Japanese development of Manchuria and

the entente cordiale between Japan and Russia.

Okuma declared that the negotiations were progressing harmoniously, and said that the entente was responsible at the present time for peace in the Orient. He added that he believed the new proposed treaty would guarantee peace in China. Then he warned the Chinese states-

men at Peking not to be misled by agents of the powers seeking to eliminate both Japan and Russia.
