If C. M. & P. S. R. R. Persists in Determination Not to Accept Franchise Containing Common User

SPOKANE, Wash., June 11.--If the Chicago, Milwaukee & Puget Sound railroad persists in its aunounced determination not to accept a franchise containing a common user clause, the North Coast, a Hill line, will be permitted to take up the union depot franchise to be prepared by the council and construct a union passenger station, which is to be open for entrance by other railroads at any future date.

This decision was reached at a meeting of the city council committee of the whole yesterday, and immediately followed a conference between all the members of the conneil and Robert E. Straporn, president of the North Const.

According to the terms of the resolution, the roads have 30 days to accept the franchises, and if in that time the Milwaukee does not file its acceptance, the North Coast railroad will be permitted to file its acceptance of the union depot franchise singly.

After a protracted conference between Milwaukee officials it was announced today that the line would continue its refusal of the common user clause.

This practically means that the road will not be allowed to enter the city, according to city officials.
