

GREAT PLANS FOR AMUSEMENT PARK

Medford People Will Soon Have Ideal Spot in Which to Find Recreation—Natorium Will Soon Be Opened.

When the plans of the Medford Natorium and Amusement company are finally completed, Medford will have one of the finest amusement parks of any city of its size on the coast.

The plans include a scenic railway, swimming tanks, chutes, a moving picture theater and besides parked grounds, where both old and young may spend their leisure hours in the open air.

The big boiler for the heating of the building and the building itself is practically enclosed. The work is being pushed forward as fast as possible, and Contractor Stewart is handicapped now only by lack of material, much of which, ordered some time ago, has failed to arrive yet.

Until one visits the grounds and estimates the magnitude of the undertaking it is difficult to realize what its completion means to the people of this city, and its environs. There will be a natorium and amusement park capable of accommodating several hundred people, with high-class amusements at a nominal price. It will be a place where one can take his family or friends for the evening with no danger of offense.
