

BUFFALO BILL'S FAREWELL TOUR

Colonel Cody's and Pawnee Bill's Wild West and Far East Combined Shows to Come to Medford This Fall—Of World Interest.

After nearly half a century of public service, first in the actual scenes of frontier life in which his dash and daring gained him fame and after its passing depicting the heroic scenes now relegated to history and collecting a congress of rough riders of the world, Colonel Cody on his farewell visit adds to his entertainment scenes from the orient by adding Pawnee Bill's Far East. It is true that the American Indian's history and origin is shrouded in the midst of unrecorded pages, but it is a sadly recorded fact that as a race he was disappearing in an equally a misty future until Colonel Cody decided to make his personality and characteristics known not only to his native land but to the most distant parts of Europe. In doing this he has assisted the historian, the writer, the painter, the sculptor, the romance, and the working people of the world the story of the conquest of a people in the white man's absorption of a continent. In this he has contributed to all the arts preservative. Were it not for Colonel Cody's repeated tours this would not have been possible through any other medium, and for this he should be greatly remembered and proper tribute paid to him on his farewell.

Beyond the American Indian he made us acquainted with that greatest of horsemen, the American cowboy and his equine antagonist, the wild horse of the plains. Extending his school to cover the horsemen of the world he has brought to the untraveled spectator specimens of every known race and nation who had special experts in the line of horsemen, notably the Russian Cossack, the South American Gauchos, the Hungarian Czikos, cavalry of our own and other nations to add to the interest of the story of American life which he produced in effective dramatic form.

His name will be long remembered, but it is a happy incident that only lately one monument, to which will soon be added another, will be connected with his memory far into the distant future. One is his interest in the development of the west, resulting in his being a factor in the erection of the highest dam in the world, the Shoshone dam in the Big Horn basin, near Cody, Wyo., and was instrumental in launching the movement initiated by the Hon. Rodman Wanamaker to build a companion monumental statue to the Goddess of Liberty in New York harbor to typify the personality of the American Indian. This work has lately been endorsed by the congress of the United States.

This final appearance of Colonel Cody and the grand program of human interest as regards the world's congress of peoples, the scenes of western and eastern life, and the magnificent exhibition of horsemanship incidental to the stories depicted elevates the occasion to an event that should interest both old and young.

On making his regretful bow it goes without saying that his patrons will wish him long life and prosperity in his retirement.

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ORDINANCE NO. 358.

An ordinance assessing the property adjacent to and benefited by the eight-inch lateral sewer constructed along Jackson street for the cost of constructing the same and providing the manner of carrying said assessments into full effect.

The city of Medford doth ordain as follows: Section 1. Whereas, the council did heretofore provide by ordinance for the serving of the owners of property adjacent to and benefited by the construction of the lateral sewer hereinafter described to appear before said council and show cause, if any, why said property should not be assessed for the construction of said sewer, and did fix a time for hearing any such protests, which notice was given in accordance with said ordinance more than ten days before the beginning of the construction of said sewer, but no protests against said construction or assessment by anyone, and said sewer was, by said council, ordered constructed; and

Whereas, the cost of the construction of said sewer has been and hereby is determined to be the sum of \$5477.69;

Now, therefore, said city doth ordain and declare that each parcel of property described below is adjacent to and benefited by that certain lateral sewer eight inches in size, constructed on Jackson street, from Bartlett street to Columbus avenue, and that the proportion of the cost of said sewer which each said parcel of land should bear based on the benefits derived respectively by said several tracts of land is the amount set opposite the description of each such parcel below, that each of said parcels is actually described in the amount set opposite its description below by the construction of said sewer, and that said several amounts represent the proportional benefits of said several parcels from said sewer. And each of said parcels is hereby assessed the amount set opposite its description below for the construction of said sewer.
