

# LOWER RATES MAY SOON BE ORDERED

### Seems a Certainty That Changes Will Be Made When Commission Compiles Immense Mass of Testimony.

PORTLAND, Aug. 4.—That the Oregon railroad commission intends to order changes in freight rates on the Southern Pacific lines south of Portland is shown by the exhaustive research being made into its rates and classifications now in effect. The commission held a lengthy hearing at Salem some weeks ago, and Tuesday the examination was finished by the railroad company introducing facts as to the movement of freight.

Business men all along the lines between Ashland and Portland have complained of freight irregularities, so the board shows, and the trouble seems to have centered on class rates, or the charges on shipments in less than carload lots. The commission has made a full investigation of rates charged and made many comparisons with rates made by other companies for similar service in an effort to get at the true facts in the cases complained of.

In the making of rates it is shown that water transportation has materially affected the railroad business at Salem, Corvallis and Albany, while to some extent the reflection of these rates is found practically to the south line of the state.

Class rates are an important item in the railroad business of Portland. Witnesses before the commission stated that the rates complained of cover nearly 50 per cent of the business to the Southern Oregon section. A slight reduction would mean a great reduction to the revenues of the road.

On the other hand, it is urged that the Southern Pacific has spent large sums for new depots, for better train service and for general improvements, and that a forced reduction in freight charges at this time would work an unjust hardship. It is shown that for many years the road in Oregon was operated at a heavy loss.

The railroad commission has an immense mass of testimony which must be compiled and considered, and it is not likely that a decision will be announced for several weeks.

When swimming back, young Herbert threw up his hands and cried loudly for help, but little attention was paid to his plea.

When it was realized that he really was drowning, it was too late to save him. The body was recovered.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 358.

An ordinance assessing the property adjacent to and benefited by the eight-inch lateral sewer constructed along Jackson street for the cost of constructing the same and providing the manner of carrying said assessments into full effect.

The city of Medford doth ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whereas, the council did heretofore provide by ordinance for the serving of the owners of property adjacent to and benefited by the construction of the lateral sewer hereinafter described to appear before said council and show cause, if any, why said property should not be assessed for the construction of said sewer, and did fix a time for hearing any such protests, which notice was given in accordance with said ordinance more than ten days before the beginning of the construction of said sewer, but no protest against said construction or assessment of the cost thereof was made by anyone, and said sewer was, by said council, ordered constructed; and

Whereas, the cost of the construction of said sewer has been and hereby is determined to be the sum of \$5477.69;

Now, therefore, said city doth ordain and declare that each parcel of property described below is adjacent to and benefited by that certain lateral sewer eight inches in size, constructed on Jackson street, from Bartlett street to Columbus avenue, and that the proportion of the cost of said sewer which each of said parcels of land should bear based on the benefits derived respectively by said several tracts of land is the amount set opposite the description of each such parcel below, that each of said parcels is actually benefited in the amount set opposite its description below by the construction of said sewer, and that said several amounts represent the proportional benefits of said several parcels from said sewer. And each of said parcels is hereby assessed the amount set opposite its description below for the construction of said sewer.
