

CRIPPEN HAS SPOKEN--DEW

Says They Are Not Trying to Make Him Confess--English Law Forbids Publishing Prisoner's Confession--Off to Niagara Falls.

QUEBEC, Que., Aug. 4.—Inspector Dew of Scotland Yard has virtually admitted that Dr. H. H. Crippen had made a definite statement to him regarding the disappearance and death of his wife, Belle Elmore Crippen.

Dew, who is awaiting the arrival of police officers and matrons to assist him in safely conducting Crippen and Miss Ethel Claire Leneve back to England, is on his way to Niagara Falls today. Before leaving, he said: "We are not seeking to compel Crippen to confess. We are not anxious to secure a confession, because he has said that he is not guilty of murder. We believe, however, that we can secure a satisfactory statement from Crippen. The English law, however, forbids our publishing a prisoner's confession."

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ORDINANCE NO. 358. An ordinance assessing the property adjacent to and benefited by the eight-inch lateral sewer constructed along Jackson street for the cost of constructing the same and providing the manner of carrying said assessments into full effect. The city of Medford doth ordain as follows: Section 1. Whereas, the council did heretofore provide by ordinance for the serving of the owners of property adjacent to and benefited by the construction of the lateral sewer hereinafter described to appear before said council and show cause, if any, why said property should not be assessed for the construction of said sewer, and did fix a time for hearing any such protests, which notice was given in accordance with said ordinance more than ten days before the beginning of the construction of said sewer, but no protests against said construction or assessment of the cost thereof was made by anyone, and said sewer was, by said council, ordered constructed; and Whereas, the cost of the construction of said sewer has been and hereby is determined to be the sum of \$5477.50; Now, therefore, said city doth ordain and declare that each parcel of property described below is adjacent to and benefited by that certain lateral sewer eight inches in size, constructed on Jackson street, from Bartlett street to Columbus avenue, and that the proportion of the cost of said sewer which each of said parcels of land should bear based on the benefits derived respectively by said several tracts of land is the amount set opposite the description of said parcels as actually benefited in the amount set opposite its description below by the construction of said sewer, and that said several amounts represent the proportional benefits of said several parcels from said sewer and each of said parcels is hereby assessed the amount set opposite its description below for the construction of said sewer.
