FELL TO DEATH IN BASEMENT

Additional Details Learned Regarding Death of Mrs. J. S. McCain of This City in Salem Recently—Was Buried Here Yesterday.

Additional details regarding the death of Mrs. J. S. McCain of this city, to those published in Sunday's issue of the Mail-Tribune are found in the following Salem dispatch:

Mistaking a door leading to the basement for one leading from the kitchen into the dining room, Mrs. J. S. McCain, of Medford, yesterday plunged head first into the basement of the former home of this city, sustaining injuries to her person which caused her death a few hours afterwards.

Mrs. McCain was the mother of Ray L. Palmer, of the firm of Wade, Pearce & Co. hardware merchants, and came to this city a few days ago to visit her son.

Yesterday afternoon she went to meet the postman and upon her return to the house, began perusing the mail. So intently did she become occupied with it that, after entering the house and while making her way, as she believed, from the kitchen to the dining room, she mistook the door leading to the basement for the dining room door and fell head first into it. In falling, her head struck against the hard stone floor, and when picked up she was unconscious.

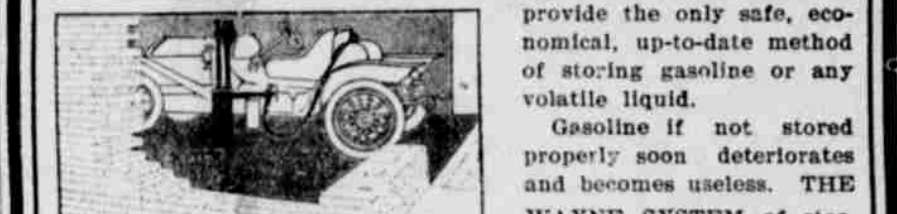

FORCED TO KILL MAN, HE SAYS

Man Admits Killing Companion But Says Three Men Forced Him to Shoot—Immediately Reported Tragedy to Picnic Party

LEWISTON, Idaho, Aug. 15.—Ernest Thomas, manager of a warehouse at Tramway, was brought to this city today and lodged in jail on a charge of having shot and killed Hugh Laverty, a well known mining man, a few miles below Kamian yesterday.

Thomas admits the killing, but states that he was directed to do so under most unusual circumstances.

The killing occurred at the John Odam cabin.

Thomas stated that he and Laverty left a picnic yesterday and started for the Odam cabin. When they reached the cabin, according to Thomas, three men were found there, and, as the door was opened, one of the men placed a shotgun in the hands of the boy and at the same time leveled his revolver at him, directing him to shoot Laverty, who was nearby. The boy scold in his fright he obeyed the comand. He states that he then returned to the cabin and found Laverty's body outside. Officers are questioning Thomas in an effort to secure a further statement which may throw light on the killing.
