NEW YORK, Sept. 10.—Most stocks showed little variation from yesterday's close when the market opened today. International Paper preferred, Pittsburg, Cincinnati, Chicago and St. Louis declined 1/8. St. Paul advanced 1/8 on the opening. The range of the other leaders was less than half a point. In the second hour the prices advanced slightly, although the bulk of the business was not great. Reading and Union Pacific were principally traded in and showed a gain of 1-2. The market closed dull.
