Crippen, the American dentist, dentist. <br> The careful work of the English mortuary authorities in building up a case from the ghastly relle found in the cella" of the Crippen house in cation satisfactory to a British jury was obtained, is a feature of the verdict. For many weeks Dr. Pepper, the government toxicologist, worked almost single-handed to gain ments to show that the remains were those of Mrs, Crippen.
