

STEER MARKET RALLIES SLIGHTLY

NORTH PORTLAND, Or., Oct. 10.—Receipts for the week ending today have been as follows: Cattle, 1833; calves, 292; hogs, 2829; sheep 2467; goats, 195.

The steer market for the week rallied slightly, one top load having brought \$5.90. The quality of the offerings were fair. The cow market remains steady. Bulls sold steady and calves were strong and high. The hog market at the week's close was about 20c, but prices ruled around 10c, but are higher than Missouri river hogs cost laid down.

Much complaint is coming in from owners of livestock, who say that banks throughout the county have loaned their available money on the wheat crop and in consequence there are no funds available for feeding cattle.
