The cost of living does not abate. In fact, it becomes a little more strenuous all the time. Butter has taken a jump of 2 1/2 c, fresh ranch bringing 32 1/2 c and creamery 37 1/2 c.

Eggs are stationary, fresh ranch being quoted at 40c. Once in a while the purchaser gets stung on those ranch eggs, for while he thinks he is buying eggs, he is sometimes buying "springs."
