Declares He is Getting Too Old to Engage Longer in Politics-Recent **Reported Scheme He Declares Is** News to Him.

PORTLAND, Or., Oct. 22.-John L. Wilson, ex-United States senator from the state of Washington, is on record today as determined to never again enter a "contest for United States senator or any other office.' Shortly after his arrival in Portland last night Wilson declared that he was getting "too old for the game of polities,"

Concerning the report that a movement had been launched to appoint Senator Jones to fill the vacancy left by the recent death of Federal Judge Whitson in Spokane and to give Wilson the senatorial toga, he said :

"This whole scheme is news to me. All I know about it is what I have read in the papers. I believe it would be better to allow those in the eastern district of Washington to settle the judgeship themselves. Care and deliberation should be exercised in selecting a judge because his appointment is for life. I do not know if Senator Jones has been consulted about using his name in this · report. I doubt if he has or if he is in favor of it. As for myself, I know I was not consulted. Politics is a hard game and I'm getting a little old now to stay in it."


