Reemer, the arrival of Idelle the First and her retinue will be heralded by a fanfare of trumpets and the party will proceed to the throneroom to the strains of the "Coronation March." The ceremony is open to the public.

Among the features will be a stately minuet, danced by four boys in court costume and powdered wigs and four girls in gowns of the period and patches. There will also be music by the military band and the Elks' quartet will sing selections arranged for the occasion. Queen Idelle will also hold a reception for the school children the afternoon of November 15.
