AMERICANS ARE ONE SOCIALIST

Natives in Gayo String Up American Rioters, Then Attack Streetcar and Injure Women and Children-Police Are Weak.

Two Americana were killed, one being lyuched by a mob during the night, in Gayo according to dispatches that reached here. The mob was composed of natives in an anti-American government revolution. American riding on the structs were stoned by the mob.

It was reported that a child rid ing on a car was struck by a ston and killed

The wildest disorder reigned during the night.. The assaults were absolutely unprocoked, according to the dispatches. One American young man as yet unidentified was caught by the mob on the outskirts and strung up to a tree. His body was cut down by the police, but life was

The rioters attacked a car in Junrez avenue on which several Americans were riding, among then being women and children. Stones were hurled through the windows. One little tot was struck on the head and killed

Several battles are reported to have occurred between the police and

The police appear to be entirely unable to cope with the situation.
