Believing that the Hill interest had not only traded worthless lands in Washington for the best of timber in Oregon tederal reserves, but that the new lands had already been sold under contract to the big lumper corporations, Senatos Chamber at the time that it was his under standing the Hill interests had acouired 100,000 acres of timber last in one Oregon county and that this was only a small part of the holding they had been able to acquire unde the provisions of the lieu hand sele-

When a big book containing rec ords of contracts in force made it appearance after an unexplained delay of many mouths, the lands which the Senta Fe milroad had traded, the lands which the Aztec Land & Cal the Co. had obtained, with other less or contracts, were stated with a lices to details which Senator Chamber hin bound as confusing as it was iseless. The real purpose of the resolution adopted by the senate, Senator Chamberlain said yesterday, has not yet been served. He believes Secretary of the Interior Ballinger should know of the transactions a is own department.

He believes that sincere investigaion will produce the records of the Hill transactions and make it imposable for the Hill interests either to rade worthless lands for millions of lollars' worth of Oregon's best timher, or to sell this timber by contract o lumber monopolies.

"I purpose to investigate this mater thoroughly on my own account. aid Senator Chamberlain vesterdar pon my return to Washington in bout a week I will have full oppor st importance that the way in which he railroads and lumber companie tave sought to monopolize Oregon' imber lands by virtue of the lieuand selection laws, should be brought to light, and the lands saved o the people, if possible."
