

# NEGROES BARRED BY GOMPERS

ST. LOUIS, Nov. 19.—Because he holds that negroes are not far enough removed from slavery to understand human rights, President Gompers of the American Federation of Labor read the negroes out of the labor movement.

"I do not condemn the negro," said Gompers, "but we cannot expect people whose mental, moral and social traditions tend toward tearing down to understand the philosophy of human rights."

If the demands of the Boilermakers employed in the Panama canal zone result in a strike, the vacancies will not be filled by mechanics from the United States, declared President Franklin of the Boilermakers' union, who is a delegate to the American Federation of Labor convention here.

## Death of Garrett Stevens.

Mr. Stevens had almost reached his 66th milestone and was still quite a strong and active man. But to the strong and active as well as to the weak and feeble death comes. The first warning came to Mr. Stevens when his tongue refused to obey the dictates of the mind and speech was gone. His tongue was paralyzed, still he was able to look after his affairs about the home and to drive to town. The second day he took to his bed. The right side gradually came under the effects of the stroke, the active mind yielded, stupor came on, unconsciousness gradually ensued and on Saturday, November 12, near the noon hour, the close came. Peacefully and without a struggle the spirit took its flight.

Mr. Stevens was born in New York City in 1844. In early life he moved to the state of Iowa, where he was living at the beginning of the civil war. He promptly enlisted in the army of the republic and served in the Twenty-second regiment, Iowa Volunteers, till the close of the war, receiving then an honorable discharge. He saw service under both Sheridan and Grant, two of the greatest Union generals. He was married in 1867 to Miss Carrie Ann Bunker, whose grandfather owned the historic old Bunker Hill, famous in revolutionary war history. For 43 years they have companied together and she is now the only known surviving relative.

Mr. Stevens was a member of the Nebraska state lodge of the A. O. U. W., in which he held a life policy for \$2000. This, with his army pension, will leave his companion of the 43 years they have journeyed happily together in comfortable condition. They also owned a pleasant little home near Phoenix. Mr. and Mrs. Stevens have both long been members of the Christian church and he died in that faith.

Sunday afternoon, November 13 the funeral was conducted from the Christian church and his body was laid away in the Phoenix cemetery. All that medical skill and good nursing and loving care could do was done, but it was the gathering of the full ripe sheaf into the garner.
