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BATTLING NELSON KNOCKED OUT BY OWEN MORAN IN THE ELEVENTH

One More Fighter Falls to Come Back—End Came Quickly—Nelson Knocked Down Five Times Before He Reached the End.

RINGSIDE BOUT'S ARENA, San Francisco, Cal., Nov. 27.—Another fighter has failed to come back, battling Nelson, "the hardest nut in the world to crack," has again been cracked, this time by Owen Moran, the doughy Bruiser.

A smashing right to the jaw did the business. Nelson went down, his face a mass of blood. At the count of eight he struggled to his feet, only to be beaten down again and again. The fifth time he failed to rise. From hands and knees at the count of ten and Referee Belg raised Moran's glove in token of victory.

The Bruiser, dazed by the battering blows, rose to his feet a second too late and feebly protested. But Belg's decision was final and unassailable.

According to a statement made by Belg immediately after the fight, Nelson was counted out and could not have gotten to his feet and confessed the fight under any conditions.

"With any other fighter I would have stopped it before the time knockdown," said Belg, "but Nelson's remarkable recuperative powers decided me against such a course. When I counted Nelson out I yelled in his ear, and he was trying all the time to force himself back, but did not have the strength."

Moran had the better of the fighting all the way. The Bruiser had lost his old strength and Moran was much the cleverer boxer. Neither man was in serious danger at any stage up to the eleventh. The end came as quick as a flash. Moran's

right about over and Nelson went down like a log.

The fight by rounds:

Round 1—Nelson lands left to face, but misses. Moran hooks light left to Nelson's face. In the breakaway Nelson lands light right. Nelson misses a low swing to the knee. Moran lands right swing to the knee. Nelson tries to hit Moran's arm, but was stopped by the referee. Nelson misses left swing. Moran misses right hook for the head. Owen swings left to stomach, but Nelson blocks cleverly. Nelson landed right in stomach. Moran lands twice, once to body and once to head. Moran rises, but Nelson met him with left and right. In the going Moran caught Nelson's hand in his own hands and tried to push him away. Even round.

Round 2—They clinch. Nelson flings Moran across the ring. The Bruiser lands the right arm around Moran's neck. Moran lands right to stomach. Moran lands straight left to jaw. Nelson lands right to stomach. Moran lands straight right to head. They clinch. Moran jabs Nelson with a straight left to the jaw. He repeated the blow a moment later, but missed a wicked right swing and the crowd yelled. Nelson lands straight left and ducked out of danger. Nelson is forcing the fighting, but seems unable to get through Moran's guard. Nelson lands right to jaw and repeated it just as the going rang. Moran's round.

Round 3—Moran lands to head with left. Nelson lands right and left to the jaw, forcing Moran against the ropes, where Owen tripped slightly and was assisted to his feet by Nelson. Nelson jabs Moran with right uppercut and rocks him with left to head. Nelson blocks left hook, but Owen landed the next one to the head. Nelson hooks left to jaw and Owen slams in hard right to the kidneys. They mix. Moran

apparently and hooks to the jaw with left. In a clinch Moran lands left hook to the nose, bringing the blood from Nelson's forehead. Moran lands light left to the jaw and another straight left to the jaw. They fiddle. Moran swings back and forth in front of the Bruiser. Moran's round.

Round 4—Moran rolled a straight left to the face. He misses another similar blow. They plunk. Moran jabs the Bruiser with left hook to the jaw. Nelson swings right to the jaw. They clinch. Moran swings right to the stomach and repeats. Moran landed straight left and right to the head. They fiddle and Moran lands straight left to the nose. Nelson misses straight left to the kidneys. Clinch. Nelson missed left hook. L. S. Berne only Nelson battered Moran right and left to the body and head. The crowd yells for Nelson. Moran striking blood. Moran lands right to the head. They clinch. Nelson misses left and Moran lands right to the jaw. Moran shoots right to the jaw and repeats. Owen batters Nelson with left and right to the head, bringing blood from Berne's cauliflower ear. They clinch. Moran lands right uppercut. The going ended a fierce mix near Nelson's corner. Even round.

Round 6—Nelson clipped Owen on the nose. They fiddle and then fall into a clinch. Nelson misses two straight lefts. They kid each other and then clinch. Nelson misses right hook and Moran sticks his glove in Nelson's nose. Moran lands left to jaw and ducks the counter. Nelson missed a wicked right swing and Owen jabs him with two straight lefts. Moran swings right to the stomach and lands right hook on the Bruiser's right shoulder. Moran lands

straight left on Nelson's sore nose. Nelson misses a vicious uppercut in the breakaway and Moran misses a straight left. Moran landed and landed left to the face and then slams right to the face. Nelson unswayed toward his corner when the bell was about to ring. It was an even thing.

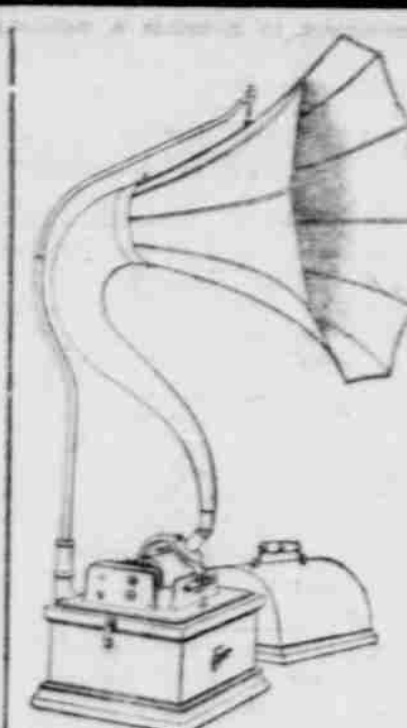
Round 7—Moran is fresher than Nelson as they shape up. He landed more blows than in previous rounds, but Nelson did all the pushing. They rush into a clinch, breaking from which Nelson lands straight left to the jaw. Moran whipped in a hard right to the stomach. They clinch. Moran ducks and lands a right to the kidneys. They clinch. Nelson misses left swing and then catches Moran with left on the ear. Nelson misses left hook to the ear and Moran counters hard to the jaw and banged Nelson on the jaw with left and right. Moran lands hard right to the stomach. Owen poked a hard left to the jaw. Nelson reaches it in the clinch. Moran lands right swing to the jaw and then right uppercut Nelson. He repeats a second later. Moran smiling over Nelson's shoulder. It was Moran's round.

Round 8—They fiddle in the center of the ring. The sun has disappeared behind a coming fog bank. Nelson lands left to the jaw and followed it up with right to the head. Nelson peppers Owen with right and left to the head. Owen lands light left to the head by his glove. Moran deliberately puts his breakaway on Nelson's nose. Moran lands right to the ear. Nelson ducked a wicked right swing and came back with a straight left to Owen's angle. Nelson whipped in left and right uppercut. Moran swings hard right cross to Nelson's jaw. Moran put a vicious right to Nelson's eye. Moran lands a hard left cross to the jaw. Nelson appears to be in a bad way. Moran opened up Nelson's right eye. Moran's round.

Round 9—Nelson put a light right to the face and Owen came back with a similar blow. Moran lands a left to the face. Nelson countered with a left to the jaw. They clinch and in the breakaway Nelson lands left right to the jaw hard. Owen put a stiff right to the jaw and Nelson replied

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with a good solid right to the stomach. Moran put a straight left to the nose and landed a very hard right to the cheek. They exchange right and left swings. Clinch. Owen put a good right swing over the kid's eyes. They were wrestling and elbowing. Coming out, Nelson put a hard right cross to the jaw and blocked a hard right for the stomach. It was an even round.

Round 10—Nelson lands straight left to jaw. They clinch and wrestle. Moran lands straight left to the face and peppers the Bruiser with right and left. Moran lands light right to the jaw. Moran

misses a wicked left. Another clinch. Moran blocked a hard right aimed for the nose. Moran's left ear bleeding. After a long clinch Moran lands uppercut. Nelson still forcing the fighting. Nelson put a hard left to the jaw. Nelson blocked hard right swing to the body. Moran lands right cross to the jaw. No demerol. Even round.

puts Nelson on the floor with a right to the jaw. Nelson rose and was again floored. Nelson was up at the count of six. Moran again dropped him. Moran put Nelson down for the fourth time with a vicious right to the jaw. Nelson went down for the fifth time, Moran slamming him on the jaw. Nelson was battered in the next five times in all. The last time he went down under a right hook and a left shove. He lit on his head and turned a complete somersault. The crowd overflowed the ring and the police were kept busy maintaining order.
