

COAST LINE TRAFFIC HELD UP BY WRECK

SAN LUIS OBISPO, Cal., Dec. 12.—Southern Pacific train No. 9, which left Los Angeles at 6:15 o'clock last evening, is off the track eight miles north of Galvota, and all traffic on the coast line will be held up at least until noon today.

The wreck, which occurred shortly before midnight, was due to a spreading rail. Engineer Chaplain brought the train to a sudden stop and undoubtedly saved many lives. With the exception of Conductor Lewis, no one was injured. Lewis was bruised and badly shaken up, but not seriously injured. He was taken to Santa Barbara.

Several Pullmans were left leaning at crazy angles against the walls of the cut in which the accident occurred.

The Palo Alto high school Rugby team, which lost the Inter-scholastic championship to the Los Angeles high school, Saturday, were returning on the wrecked train. During the morning the players donned their uniforms and entertained the passengers with an impromptu game.
