

NO NEW TRIAL FOR JAPANESE MURDERER

DENVER, Colo., Dec. 17.—G. Mitsunaga, convicted of murdering Mrs. Katherine Wilson, was denied a new trial today by Judge Shattuck, and his sentence of life imprisonment was affirmed. The defense was allowed 60 days in which to file an appeal.

The Mitsunaga case attracted international attention through the charges made by the local Japanese consul that he was unfairly tried through prejudice against his race. The Japanese ambassador at Washington personally watched its procedure and directed Mitsunaga's attorneys to spare no pains to secure a new trial.
