

STRIKE RIOTS SWAY WINNIPEG

WINNIPEG, Man., Dec. 21.—Strike disorders resembling somewhat those of the street railroad strike four years ago last summer, broke out last evening. Twelve of the largest cars were sent out about six o'clock to Weston to bring Canadian Pacific railway employees to their work in the city. There are 4000 men employed at the shops and complaints had been made to the company that no effort had been made to bring these mechanics to their homes. The company therefore made extra endeavors to show their strike resources. When the cars arrived at the railway shop-substation they waited for passengers, but all the employees passed them walking home. After a few minutes' wait the streetcars decided that a trap had been set for them and made up their minds to start their cars back. All went well for half an hour. Then the first car ran into an obstruction of ties that were chained to the rails, and the second car went off the tracks in some mysterious way. While the crews were holding a council of war

in the dark and in the midst of a blinding snow storm, the spot became black with men. The crews had barely time to escape to the cars and hide under the seats before a fusillade of missiles started. This bombardment kept up until every pane of glass was broken and the cars in other ways rendered useless for service. Then the rioters returned and

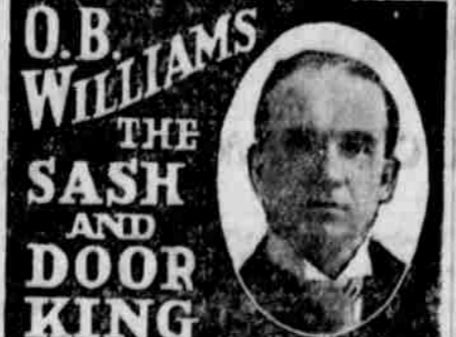

the men crawled out from under the seats, bruised and battered. An urgent call was sent for the police and detachments soon arrived, but too late to be of service except to convey several of the crew to the hospital to have their bruises attended to and cuts sewn up.
