NEGOTIATIONS WITH CANADA TO RE-OPEN

OTTAWA, Ont., Jan. 6.—When Ministers Fieiding and Paterson resume at Washington on Saturday the reciprocity negotiations carried on here last November they will deal directly with Mr. Knox, American secretary of state, and when necessary, with President Taft.
