# NEW BOOKS IN PUBLIC LIBRARY

THE REST PROPERTY AND ADDRESS OF During December Fifty-eight Nev Volumes Are Added-Some Them Are Especially Valuable a Reference Books.

During the month of December 58 fine new books were placed upon the shelves of Medford's public library. and among them are some works of exceptional interest and merit. Noteworthy among these are: The Riders of the Plains, by A. L. Haydon, a comprehensive and at the same time thrilling history of the coming and subsequent progress of the northwest mounted police; The Holy Land, by Robert Hickens, which is a model of achievement both in the literary material and in the exquisite colored illustrations with which the work abounds; From Irish Casties to French Chateaux, one of Norma Bright Carson's charming and valuable accounts of travel and study. and last and probably the most exceptional acquisition of all, the four De Luxe volumes on The Fine Arts and their accompanying study brochures, as published by the National Art society at Chicago. This set of books, beautifully bound in moroceo and profusely illustrated with choice photographs, etc., will be accessible as reference works only, as their exceptional value makes it impossible that they should circulate commonly as do the other books. Up to this time in Medford students of art subjects have been obliged to depend upon such private libraries as they could reach for instructive literary material, but with the aid of this valuable work, which is, in comparatively brief compass, a university course on architecture, sculpture, painting, and decoration in their history, development and principles, those interested can find a satisfactory and wholly delightful reference work,

### AMENDMENT OFFERED TO COMMERCE LAWS

WASHINGTON, D. C., Jan. 7 .-An amendment to the interstate commerce laws to prevent monopolies was introduced today by Knowland. Calif. It provides that it shall be unlawful for any railroad or common earrier to own or control or have any interest whatever in a steamship line 6 common earrier by water. The principal object is to prevent railroad monopoly of the freight earrying service through the Panama canal. It will, Knowland believes, enforce competition between the transcontinental railroads and the Panama Canal steamship lines,
