STATE OF ENGLISH MARKET IS BETTER

We are very pleased to open the nev year by reporting a better state of things in England as per cables. reporting as follows:

Liverpool-L. Connolly & Co. cable that at today's offering there was an eager demand for 4-tier Watsonville Newtowns at 8s, and Oregons, 112 to 150 size, 9s 6d, and 165 size, at 9s.

London-M. Issaes & Sons cable that fresh arrivals of Newtowns are selling from 7s to 8s and that the prospects are more favorable.

The exports of box apples from here last week were as follows: Liverpool, 7000 boxes; Landon, 4000 boxes, and the continent, 2000 boxes Of course these are small shipments, but probably quite enough, and we are glad to see them small, as it aids in sustaining the foreign markets.

Of course there are no cars of any consequence rolling from your coast, but the quantity stored in this cityy in Chicago are very heavy, a large share naturally being red apples from the northwest,

No offerings at auction since our last; in fact, only two cars yesterday and two today at private sale, all out of cold storage. One car was from Medford, Spitzenbergs, pretty nice, \$2.50 asked, but not obtainable. Another was of Newtowns, and we know a few of the very largest sizes sold at \$2. The other two cars were from Hood River, with a variety of kinds, qualities, etc. Of course it is too near New Year's for any sales of consequence to take place, and we are glad to have the consumption go on without offerings of consequence.

Notwithstanding the depression in box apples, the prices of barrel apples continue strong and in many cases actually advancing, \$4.55 and \$5.50 per barrel are demanded and obtained. We are in hopes that some of this advance will shortly strike the box apple business. There were January 1st (four days ago) fully 400,000 boxes of apples, Newtowns and red apples, stored in the several large cold storage warehouses in this city and Jersey City a heavier quantity than ever known previously. It is said that in the western part of this state there are over 100,-000 boxes stored and in Chicago perhaps 300,000, although this is guess work. However, you will see that the combined figures make a very heavy supply.
