ORDINANCE NO. 144. An ordinance declaring the assessment on the property benefited for the cost of laying a 6-inch water main on South Grape street from Twelfth street to south city limits, and directing the recorder to enter a statement thereof in the water main lien docket.

The city of Medford doth ordain as follows: Section 1. Whereas, the city council did heretofore, by resolution declare its intention to lay a 6-inch water main on South Grape street from Twelfth street to south city limits, and to assess the cost thereof on the property fronting on said portion of said street in proportion to the frontage of said property, and fix a time and place for hearing protests against the laying of said water main on said part of said street and the assessment of the cost thereof as aforesaid.

And whereas, said resolution was duly published and posted as required by section 116 of the charter of said city: And whereas, a meeting of the council was held at the time and place fixed by said resolution for the purpose of considering any such protests, but no protests were at said time, or at any other time made or to be received by the council to the said laying of said water main or the assessment of the cost thereof as aforesaid, and said council having considered the matter, and deeming that said water main was and would be of material benefit to said city, and that all property to be assessed therefor would be benefited thereby to the extent of the probable amount of the respective assessments to be levied against said property, did order said main laid.

And whereas, the cost of said water main has been and hereby is determined to be the sum of \$278,152.

An ordinance assessing the property specially benefited by the opening of Park avenue.
