

CITY NOTICES.

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ORDINANCE NO. 372. An ordinance assessing the property adjacent to and benefited by the 6-inch lateral sewer constructed along Laurel street from Eighth street to Tenth street...

Section 2. It is further ordered that the notice above provided for be published three times in the Daily Mail Tribune, a newspaper published and of general circulation in said city...

Section 1. Whereas, the council did heretofore provide by ordinance for the serving of the owners of property adjacent to and benefited by the construction of the lateral sewer hereinafter described to appear before said council and show cause, if any, why said property should not be assessed for the construction of said sewer...
