

ASHLAND TO BAR SUNDAY SHOWS

City Council Prepares to Settle Sunday Evening Controversy By Closing all Picture Houses on that Night—Churches Object.

ASHLAND, Feb. 3.—Moving picture shows in Ashland will be prohibited from running on Sunday, the city council having passed to second reading an ordinance to that effect, and it will carry at next meeting. A committee of the Young People's Union was before the council at the meeting last Thursday evening and saw an ordinance they had prepared by Attorney W. J. Moore formally read.

The state law and the constitution of Oregon had been carefully looked up before this ordinance was drawn, and it was concluded that while the state law read that theatrical exhibitions may be given on Sunday, the wording was such that it did not say they should be given permission, hence, the interpretation is left with the city council of the state to use their discretion.

Wants Prisons Self Supporting.

SACRAMENTO, Cal., Feb. 3.—To make California state prisons self supporting bills were introduced in both houses of the legislature today, backed by a message from Governor Johnson. Prisoners will be instructed in making materials and supplies for the state, counties and municipalities required by the measure to buy the output. Union labor endorses the idea. Private sale of products of the prisons is forbidden.
