Early California Lettuce Is Quoted by Local Produce Men at 10 Cents Per Head—The First "Early" to Arrive—More to Follow Soon.

California lettuce, at 10 cents a head, is the latest addition to the list of produce on sale at the local stands. This tasty green is to be had in quantities and is the first of the early produce received from the Golden state.

Eggs still remain the same but are predicted to be due for a fall in price soon.

With the breaking up of the winter California produce may be expected at any time. The season there, like here has been delayed by the cold winter.

Oregon Newtowns Bring From Ten to Eleven Shillings in Liverpool—Red Apples Sell in New York for \$2.50 Per Box.

Sgobel & Day issue the following under date of New York, February 14:

The market in Liverpool now as per cable just received from L. Connolly & Co., is as follows: Newtowns—California 4-tier 7s 6d to 7s 9d; 4 1-2-tier, 7s to 7s 3d; Oregon, 10s 11d, poor condition. 8s.

We have no cable from London today.

One car of Watsonville Newtowns, 4-tier, sold here at auction this morning a few at \$1.70, but the bulk at \$1.65, and we do not think the fruit was of the highest grade, pretty ripe.

Of red apples from the northwest (two or three cars daily are taken out of cold storage and put on the Erie wharf, which sell all the way from \$1.50 to \$2.50, according to the fruit and the pack, color, style, etc. Some good firm varieties of other red apples are in better demand than the Spitzenbergs and of course the latter are getting pretty ripe, naturally so, being mostly large.

The total shipments of box apples for the past few weeks have been as follows:

January 14, 37,800; January 21, 33,000; January 28, 34,500; February 4, 30,500; February 11, 26,200.
