STOCK SHOW AT PORTLAND

First Annual Exhibition of Its Kind Ever Held West of Denver Scheduled for Union Stock Yards on March 20.

PORTLAND, Or., March 3 .- The fut stock show at the Union stockyards in North Portland, March 20, 21 and 22 will be the first annual exhibition of its kind held west of Denver. It will be purely educational, there being no admission fee. and the plan is to promote the interests of the livestock man. Cattle horse, sheep and hogs will be shown

James J. Hill of the Great Northern and Judge Robert S. Lovett of the Harriman lines have lent their support to the show and the two railroad systems will co-operate a every way to make it a success. During the show there will be a sale of thoroughbred beef eattle and a great display of draft horses will be a feature. A special rate of one and onethird fares has been granted by the railroads from Washington, Oregon Idaho and northern California.

Although it costs nothing to enter stock prizes will be liberal, some amounting to \$150 each. These are offered for cattle, grade and crossbred simble steers, swine, sheep. wethers and draft horses and there will also be a killing contest.

There will be a students' judging contest on the afternoon of the first day, followed by lectures on livestock topics. On March 21 will be judging of carload lots of cattle, judging o single steers; judging ears of hogs a pens of five; judging sheep in carloads; judging sheep in pens of five judging wethers, single animals.

On the morning of March 22 there will be a sale of fat cattle, and awards in the killing contest will be ennounced, followed by judging draft horse, in harness. In theafternoon there will be a sale of registered car-
