ST. PETERSBURG, Mch. 6.inety persons, mostly children, were ourned and trampled to death in a ire here yesterday in a moving picure theatre at Beloge. Forty were eriously injured.

Five hundred were in the theatre when it caught fire from an explotion of the moving picture machine.

The audience became panic-strickn, and in their mad rush for the exts, clogged the doors and passenfeways. Men, in their frenzy of terror eat down women and children and armpled them under foot,

Few of the bodies of the victims vere recognizable,

WITH PLOT TO MURDER TAFT

Many Crimes Are Laid at Door of Two Spokane Men-Police Have Watched Them Since Sullivan Was Killed-Mayor Pratt Was to Go.

PLOT TO ASSASSINATE PRESIDENT IS UNEARTHED

One of the Men is Said to Have Been Instigator in Haymarket Riots and the Other a "Red."

SPOKANE, Wash., Mch. 6. Involving an alleged plot on the part of Eastern anarchists to kill President Taft when he leaves the White House on his vacation, the contemplated murder of Mayor Spratt, the murder of Spokane captain of police, and other crimes were embodied in charges filed against Stuart Moffett and John Steel here today.

Moffett is alleged to have been ne of the instigators of the Haymarcet riots and Steele is alleged to be one of the inner circle of anarchists. They were arrested Friday night when Moffett was found lollering round the residence of Mayor Pratt.

Both Moffett and Steel have been n Spokane for several years, Since he murder of Captain Sullivan, when their suspicious actions attracted atentional at the funeral, they have een under surveillance. .

Steel is alleged to have told Mofftt and another man after the shootng of Captain Sullivan that he left he scene and walked down the prinipal streets to the business district, cassing numerous policemen as they burried back and forth in search of

They first planned to kill Mayor Pratt, it is charged, as Captain Sulivan was killed.

Moffett reconnollered the Pratt ome, the police say, and found an armed guard watching the residence. He reported this to Steel and the pair declared they would "get him" some other way. Moffett went back Friday night to see if the guard could not be avoided or put out of he way that more mystery might be ittached to the crime, it is alleged.

The first plan of the alleged conspirators was to wait until after elecion, says Captain of Detectives M. J. Burns. For some unknown reason. the men are alleged to have changed their plans,
