ALASKA TOWN SUFFERS FIRE

With Temperature Below Zero Citizens of Douglas City Fight Fire Which Threatens to Completely Wipe Out The City.

JUNEAU, Alaska, March 10. — With the temperature below zero, the citizens of Douglas City, on an island across the bay from Juneau are today fighting a fierce fire that threatened at daybreak to completely wipe out the city. There are more than 4000 people in the city, 2000 being employed in the famous Treadwell gold mines. A high wind is raging across the channel and no help can be sent from this city until the storm abates. All of the mines were closed down today, the men working with the volunteer firemen to hold down the fire. The entire business section is said to have been wiped out last night by flames.
