The bark beetle, in passing from the back to the heart of the tree, causes the pitch to form in what is known as "pitch tubes," or warts, on the outside of the tree. This renpermits a small ground fire to become a raging conflagration. Inasmuch as the beetles are prevalent in Shasta and Sisklyou counties, the State Forester will do his utmost to exterminate them; also, to prevent their restructive work by the organization of forest protective associa
