TAFT AND CABINET WILL CONFER TONIGHT REGARD THE MEXICAN SITUATION

WASHINGTON, D. C., March 20 -Although no official confirmation could be obtained, the report that President Taft and his cabinet were to meet tonight to discuss important new developments in the Mexican situntion was generally eredited here today.

Taft arrived at noon from Atlanta and cabinet members who have been out of town have returned. The president is said to be greatly worried over indications that an unfriendly congress probably will demand an investigation of the mobilization.
