

# ONE MORE PIONEER PASSES TO BEYOND

W. H. Bostwick, for Many Years a Resident in the Applegate Section Passed Away Friday Night at Midnight.

W. H. Bostwick, one of the oldest pioneers in southern Oregon, answered the final call Friday night. Mr. Bostwick has been afflicted with cancer of the stomach and liver and for the past three months has been receiving treatment at the home of his son-in-law, Mr. Schultz, residing at 129 N. Central avenue.

Last evening he became worse and at 12 o'clock death summoned him. Mr. Bostwick has lived for many years in the Applegate valley and his old pioneer friends were shocked to hear of his death, yet for the past month little hope was given for his recovery.

The deceased was 65 years of age. He leaves a widow, a son, and two daughters.

He leaves 10 children besides a widow. His children are William T. Dora, Cameron, John E., Charles W., Emma G., Payne, Bert B., Hattie Lyons, Lena K. Shultz, and two brothers, Irvine Day Bostwick and Lee Vance Bostwick.

The funeral will be held at 2 p. m. today at the grave. The body will be interred in the Jacksonville cemetery. He has been a resident of the Applegate valley for the past 29 years.

# ELECTRICITY IN PURIFICATION OF WATER

In a letter to the director of the department of public works, Philadelphia, Pa., Mr. W. W. Gibbs, president of the United Water Improvement company, gives some interesting figures on the results obtained in the use of electricity, for removal of bacteria from large quantities of water. Tests have been made at a plant having a capacity of 1,000,000 gallons of water per day. Bacteriological examination showed that the raw water of the Schuylkill river at a certain point contains as high as 2,500,000 bacteria per cubic centimeter; after a rough straining, to remove the coarser particles of suspended matter, the water contains from 253,000 to 700,000 bacteria; after ozonization it contains from 5 to 55.

The process of ozonization is electrical, current at 100 cycles and 10,000 volts being employed. By the use of inductance coils and condensers numerous discharge points assist in the formation of pencils of blue light. Atmospheric air, which is drawn across these points by means of an air-pump, is thus converted partially into ozone. verted partially into ozone. The ozonized air is then forced through a standpipe in which it emits a current of water flowing in the opposite direction. The contained bacteria are destroyed by the ozone. It is stated that about 200 kw-hours of electrical energy are required for each million gallons of water treated.
